Most importantly, it would give private citizens standing to file a suit in court requiring that scientific evidence of harm be heard. This means people can object to a polluting project before they have asthma or cancer.

This certainly seems fair to me. And I don't see anything in our State Constitution that enshrines a right for corporations to cause public health risks.
