I urge you to oppose HB 2316-1, which would allow housing development on stateowned lands outside urban growth boundaries (UGBs) by designating them as "Home Start Lands."

While I appreciate your concern for seeking solutions to Oregon's housing shortage, this bill, as written, is not helpful. Perons needing housing need to be close to infrastructure not isolated outside the UGB where they will need a car to commute and will not be near needed services. The solution to the housing and homelesness crisis is not to authorize development whereever there is available land. The common sense and helpful approach is to locate this housing where there is infrastructure not outside the UGB. This bill does not do that. Please oppose this proposal.
