Dear Members of the Senate Committee on Rules,

I am writing to support SJR 28, which proposes an amendment to the Oregon Constitution to establish a fundamental right to a clean, safe and healthy environment.

This amendment is necessary as, according to the Cherniak v. Oregon Decision at Oregon Supreme Court (2020), the Oregon constitution only protects navigable waters fall under the public trust doctrine, leaving land, air, groundwater, and other resources unprotected. The ruling highlights a major gap in Oregon law and regulations: courts have refused to recognize the state's duty to protect critical natural resources and state agencies lack a general mandate to provide a healthy environment.

SJR28-1 explicitly includes public trust doctrine protections for all natural resources and a stable climate. Enshrining these rights in the constitution guarantees that Oregon's natural resources are protected for future generations.

Please refer this proposed amendment to a vote of the people.
