My name is Beatrice Karanja, and I live in Troutdale. I am a single mother of three children and the caregiver for my elderly mother. I work as a home care provider, helping others maintain their dignity and health, yet I struggle every day to provide those same things for my own family.

My pay is modest, and because of my immigration status, I am excluded from food assistance. It is heartbreaking to return home after a long day of caregiving and still not have enough food for my children or my mother. We cut back, we ration, and I often go without so they don't have to.
