I am also enthusiastic about the fact that the bill further provides that any person may invoke this amendment to obtain equitable relief against state action or inaction that harms the environment. The bill directs courts to view laws and regulations that provide for a healthy environment, including climate, as compelling state interests. It's about time.

Although the amendment would not enact any specific mandates, it would provide an important backstop to safeguard the people's health and safety against actions that would harm the environment and/or worsen climate change. The Right to a Healthy Environment has been enacted in other states, where it has been effective in furthering this aim.
