If it could do so much for me imagine what it does for those in our program. At A Family Gathering Place we serve 42 of the highest needs families and have a waitlist of 32. We are expanding our area of services through a new contract to provide outreach services to lake county along with those we serve in the Klamath Basin. We see and hear that there is more need for support services in our area and are trying to make that happen.
