Return us to paper ballots, in-person voting with proof of identification and citizenship, on a single day, no late ballots, no counting after observers go home for weeks, no machines, hand counting only, using volunteers only, at the precinct level, with volunteer election observers, results known and published the evening of voting day. Completely abandon existing voter roles, require eligible voters to reregister, with proof of ID and citizenship. No more registration through attestation of citizenship, no registering online or by mail. No more registration through numerous agencies that themselves attest to the security and integrity of their contributions to our voter roles. Open every step of election to the public review, including all election materials and results for citizen audit, no more huge fees to discourage. Our elections are the among the most important factors in enabling self governance, by We the People, and they have been long compromised, likely starting when Oregon introduced vote by mail.
