Chair Prozanski and Vice-Chair Thatcher,

Thank you for the opportunity to submit testimony in opposition to SB 243 and the -1 Amendment. The -1 Amendment is the fantasy of every anti-gun organization and is an all out attack on honest, law-abiding citizens like myself and family. I urge you to oppose this terrible piece of legislation and let it die in committee.

Giving any other governmental body than the state legislature the authority to regulate the possession of concealed firearms is ridiculous and will only turn lawabiding citizens into felons. Criminals don't follow our laws. If they did there would be no shootings in "gun-free zones." The only people that obey these fantasy land gunfree zones that have been dreamt up by anti-gun Senators are law-abiding citizens. We aren't the problem, but maybe that's the point. If this passes even walking down the sidewalk in my neighborhood I could become a felon without even knowing it. Walking past a school, irrigation district or any number of other special districts of the government you are giving this authority to could make up their own bans. In every other aspect of governance we strive for consistency, yet on this issue Democrats are perfectly fine with a patchwork of different laws that could changes 100 times between Pendleton and Salem. Think about it. Most of you sitting on this committee have voted for consistency in state regulations. Armed veterans standing guard outside of our schools would prevent school shooters or at the worst, stop them in their tracks. That's common sense. The only way to stop a bad guy with a gun is a good guy with a gun, not a sign telling them it's a gun-free zone.

Instead of enforcing the laws we have you would rather attack our Constitutional

Right to own and possess firearms. Adding a 72 hour waiting period will do one thing, endanger the lives of law-abiding citizens by preventing them from obtaining a firearm when they need it to protect themselves. You're focusing on making gun owners felons instead of enforcing the laws we have. If this weren't true then please explain why you're not up in arms over the fact that the Oregon State Police isn't arresting and charging every felon that attempts to purchase a gun illegally? There's literally a record of it and it's a felony. My bet is it raises more campaign cash to go after our gun rights than it does using common sense to address criminal activity or the mental health crisis in this state.

There are solutions available to you without passing this assault on our Constitutional right.
