I support SB 210; for in person voting. It will re-establish our previous process of voting. It will create fair and accurate voting. We will only have citizens who are registered, legal citizens of the United States voting. If an American went to any other country we would not be able to vote in their elections; so why should illegal individuals be voting in ours. In late 2024, the DMV admitted they registered 1, 259 illegal citizens to vote. The requirement to show picture ID and a precinct card or other indication is the safest way to have honest and fair elections. In my opening statements I referred to our previous process. I remember as a young child my grandmother would visit her other children in other states and she would simply ask/request an absentee ballot.

If there is one change I would suggest for the bill it would be to make the deadline 5-days before election day; absentee ballots have to be returned. It will create better security to our elections by closing the gap of "days gone by" It will help to eliminate any fraudulent activities. The longer the time the easier it would be to create fraudulent activity.
