Registration to vote at the DMV should not be a DMV worker's responsibility to ensure that non Oregonian and non citizens end up with voting rights which has happened and we have admitted noncitizens voting in our elections. Once this was shown to the state and our new attorney general the voter registration system at the DMV was shutdown and a partial investigation was completed and they started the DMV voter registration was started again. Federal law requires that a state must do a full investigation of all of the voter registration base and has refused to do so.
