Encouraging participation in our representative democracy is a cornerstone of a well functioning democracy. Oregon's mail in voting has proven to be cost effective, efficient, safe and it encourages individuals to participate in our democracy and exercise their right to vote. There is negligible evidence of fraud or abuse in the Oregon system. Given the rural nature of much of the state, mail in voting makes voting far more accessible to many voters. No reasonable person can look at the facts and evidence of Oregon's mail in voting system and make any conclusion other than it works well. The only reason to require in-person voting would be to disenfranchise voters in rural areas, voters of limited means or who lack transportation, voters with disabilities or voters who cannot physically get to the polls on election day due to work, travel, weather, illness or intimidation.
