About: Senate Bill 210

Chair Sen. Jama, Vice Chair, Vice-Chair Sen. Bonham and Members of the Senate Committee on Rules:

I strongly support SB 210, requiring Oregonians to vote in person and show ID to prove that each person is qualified to vote. Our voter rolls are among the worst in the nation, and it's public knowledge that non-qualified people have been added through the DMV and OHA.

Details can be worked out, such as:

- Declaring Election Day to be a 24-hour holiday

- Voting within precincts and counting the ballots within that 24-hours

- Observers and vote tallying participants from both the Democrat and Republican parties

 - It does not take weeks to count ballots by hand – France can do it in one evening

 - There would be no machine glitches, and power outages won't matter

- Even the former Oregon District Attorney Rosenblum testified in court that our voting machines can be hacked
