My name is Faith Roberts.

I am in support of this bill.

It only makes sense that if people appear in person and show ID that there will be far less opportunity for fraud in our voting system .

I have lived in Oregon for 52 years and prior to vote by mail without ID we had Republican governors (almost every other election cycle) and sometimes a majority of republicans in the state legislature.
