Dear Chair Senator Kayse Jama, Vice-Chair Senator Daniel Bonham, and
Committee Members,

I strongly support HB 210, and I'd like to thank Senator David Brock Smith for
sponsoring this bill.

There weren't claims of voter fraud when in-person-voting was established, like there
have been since mail-in-voting. Therefore, it is a sound method for voting.
Additionally, requiring legal citizenship and Oregon ID is an intelligent thing to do
because non-citizens and non-Oregonians should not have a say in Oregon matters.
Furthermore, it is wise to require ballots be filled out/returned by the date of the
election because it gives less opportunity for voter fraud to happen.

Secondly, provision in this bill for mail-in-voting for Oregonian-citizens who are
unable to vote in-person is greatly appreciated. (If individuals take time to read the bill
for themselves they will see that this provision exists.)

Why not vote in support of SB 210 and allow the act to be referred to the people for
their approval or rejection at the next general election?
