I support removing vote by mail. I support requiring in person voting, which requires proving citizenship and the right to vote in the specific area. This will prevent voter fraud of ineligible voters and people who try to influence the outcomes of areas where they should have no say.

Personal experience: After DROPPING my ballot off to an official ballot box, I was informed two weeks later that my ballot was accepted and counted. TWO weeks after the election results were in, my vote was counted. In person voting eliminates that. In person voting allows me to know that my vote actually means something.
