Oregon has among the highest turnout in national elections because of our mail-in vote standard. It allows voting to be flexible, so everyone can vote without worrying about finding childcare, taking time off work, or getting to polling places. People who have mobility challenges have a lower barrier to participating in the democratic process. Voting by mail creates a more equitable democratic process, and there is no evidence that it leads to an increase in any kind of election fraud.
