Measure, Appointment or Topic: SB210

I oppose SB 210, a repeal of the ability of Oregonians to vote by mail.

In 1998, Oregon voters approved Measure 60, the ability to vote by mail, by a margin of 69.3% to 30.6% with 1.1 million people casting ballots; a significant landslide by the majority of citizens.

The passage of SB 210 would require the establishment of polling places which would be an unnecessary cost burden to the state and would be a hardship for rural voters.
