My name is Tracy Bryce Farmer. I am a Licensed Clinical Social Worker and Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor operating a private practice in Portland, Oregon. I am writing to urge you to pass HB 3197.

Oregon ranks among the worst states for high levels of alcohol and drug abuse for youth. It doubles down on this failure by being among the worst states for access to substance use disorder treatment for individuals and families. As a social worker and addictions counselor, I see every day the destruction wreaked on Oregon's youth by these systemic deficits as well as the cultural promotion of drug and alcohol use. Between the cannabis industry, our entrepreneurial cottage industry for hallucinogens, and the notorious consequences of Measure 110, youth are hard pressed to avoid catastrophic experimentation with high-risk substances.
