

I am testifying in support of Senate Bill 210, making in person voting the standard for Oregon elections. Here in my city of Springfield close to my home there are dozens of voters registered at addresses where they do not live. Even a cursory examination of the voter roll shows an absurd number of voters registered at modest single family homes and apartments. How can there be 6, 7 or 8 registered voters in homes that are not legal to have that many occupants?

The public's confidence in our elections process has collapsed nationwide. Other countries such as India Mexico and Germany have in person voting. We need to restore confidence in our elections by bringing Oregon up to international standards.

This is how citizens vote in India. Please bring Oregon up to these standards.
