I strongly support mail in voting for the following reasons:

- 1. It is more convenient. You get to fill out your ballot in your own home at a time that works for you.
- 2. It is more convenient. You can mail or drop-box your ballot and skip the polling place lines.
- 3. Everyone gets a ballot.
- 4. Because of #1, # 2, #3 above, voter participation is likely to be higher, especially if inclement weather, lack of childcare, illness, confusion as to where to cast in-person ballots, can't get time off work or other issues are present.
- 5. Mail in voting has been proven to be safe. Documented instances of abuse, coercion, or fraud barely register as a percentage.
