My spouse and I have two children who were conceived through sperm donation. At the time we began constructing our family we were not aware of the consequences of donor anonymity. Luckily we selected a donor that is open ID at 18. We feel strongly now it is absolutely in our children's best interest to have access to information about the donor for identity formation and genetic purposes. Arguably age 18 is even too late to know this information. I can say with certainty the time will come much sooner than that where they will ask questions about their donor. There will be little that we can tell them, but I'm grateful we can tell them anything at all. The livelihoods of people conceived via gamete donation deserve to be valued over financial gains of for profit corporations, many of which have been deceptive at best.
