In previous years I lived in Minnesota when it was strictly at-the-polls voting. Despite prior studying at home and bringing a list of my planned votes, there were always downballot races such as school boards, commissions, judges and ballot measures that I was not aware would be on the ballot. This meant guessing or skipping those items.

Vote-by-mail, and in particular our current method of no postage required and counting votes postmarked by election day, allows for a more informed electorate and greater opportunity to vote.

I urge that you maintain the current system and refuse this movement toward decreasing voter participation.
