Our voting system is not broken- so there is no need to tinker with it! I have lived in Oregon for 15 years and can say that our current mail-in voting system is absolutely better than requiring in-person voting. Long lines and scarce polling locations in the middle of a Tuesday make it cumbersome or nearly impossible for many folks to vote in person. This includes elderly people with limited mobility, anyone working on a weekday, anyone without a flexible schedule, anyone without a car or transit that day, anyone who is ill, travelling, injured, etc. It would be a terrible step backwards to end mail-in voting.
