I am writing in opposition to SB 210.

Our mail-in voting system allows for some of the highest voter turnout in the country. The ability for Oregon residents to vote on a timeline that works for all individuals regardless of work schedule, school schedule, family schedule, or otherwise is something we should be celebrating, not removing.

Single-day in-person voting consistently results in certain groups being largely unable to vote. Unless the state makes election days state holidays with all businesses closed, then a single day of in-person voting will disenfranchise massive numbers of people.
