SB210

The citizens of Oregon have been privileged to exercise our franchise by mail, in primary and general elections, for over 25 years. Over those years, the instances of non-citizen voting has been vanishingly rare. This bill, if passed, will not appreciably decrease the possibility of non-citizen voting, but will almost certainly create an additional barrier to voter turnout by requiring in person voting. I urge you to consider your lesser-abled constituents when deciding how to proceed with SB 210; voting by mail is demonstrably easier for Oregonians to perform their civic responsibility.
