Measure, Appointment or Topic: SB210

Since vote-by-mail is the most fraud friendly means of voting, as per a federal report co-written by Jimmy Carter more than a decade ago, I STRONGLY SUPPORT PASSAGE OF SB210.

In so doing, Oregonians can once again BEGIN TO have confidence in the integrity of a voting process that is plagued by outdated voter rolls, as witness by Oregon being sued by Judicial Watch for fraudulent rolls; where dead people and those no longer living in Oregon cast many ballots; ballot stuffing at drop boxes, and noncitizen voting, among others.

In-person voting at a local precinct voting is not racist, as deluded groups claim; rather, all people, regardless of race are more than intelligent enough to determine where a precinct is located in their neighborhood and how to get there.
