Measure, Appointment or Topic: SB210

I strongly oppose SB210. It is another attempt by the GOP to further disenfranchise already marginalized voters. Oregon is a leader in voter turnout because of historical efforts to ensure eligible voters receive ballots and can then mail them in. Changing our current laws to require in-person only would lead to a significant decrease in voter turnout and allow for certain districts to make access to voting locations difficult to access (as many areas in predominantly GOP held areas regularly do). SB210 is an attack on voter rights and should be immediately rejected.
