Honorable Chair Senator Jama, Vice Chair Bonham, Members Senators Golden, Manning Jr. and Thatcher,

Honrable Senators, I am in favor of SB210 which makes in-person voting on the date of the elections the standard method for conduction an election.for the following reasons.

- It has been studies by numerous organizations including the Congress starting in 2005 through the Baker Institute in the <u>Baker Carter Report</u> 20 years later and found voting in person to be the safest way to vote, in fact vote by mail is the most vulnerable to fraud that we have. I also submitted a pdf of their report to my testimony.
- 2. This Bill SB210 still has a flaw in that you can still vote by mail if you are out of the area. <u>Mexico</u> that went trough over 10 years of battle on this subject and does not allow even this method of ballot submission. If you are not at your home base to vote in person with your ID which was gotten months ahead of time, you cannot vote. They have many safeguards to their electios and was very interesting that they outlawed vote by mail. Even if this bill SB210 passes, we would still be one of the most vulnerable election processes in the world because we allow people out of the area to vote here.
- 3. Recent investigation of people who came here illegally (by the millions) are registered to vote. Antonio Gracias has been helping DOGE at Social Security and found that millions of the illegal immigrants let in by the Biden administration are on taxpayer-funded benefits programs.
