I strongly oppose this bill. Oregon has had vote-by-mail for over two decades. There is no significant evidence of fraud with vote-by-mail in Oregon or anywhere else, to the best of my knowledge. I recall an attempt in North Carolina related to the 2020 election that was perpetrated by a Republican who was caught and held accountable by the justice system under existing law.

Going to the polls, in my opinion is not convenient for many: time off from work, child care, transportation challenges, illness or other medical issues can make going to a polling place not possible for some. Vote-by-mail overcomes those limitations. This proposal seems to be something out of the Project 2025 playbook. Please vote against it. I believe the electorate will take note.
