To Senate Committee on Rules Regarding SB 210 (submitted by Sen. Smith, Port Orford) 31 March 2025

Voting by mail has been convenient and essentially devoid of fraud for 26 years. Changing to virtually all voting by mail (SB 60, 1998) has increased voter participation, particularly in elections for national and state-wide elections. Voting by mail has been efficiently and well administered by the office of the Secretary of State. Do not ask voters to support the present, excellent mail voting in any forthcoming election. Note that voting for

SB 210 for 2025 must again be conducted by mail. Perhaps learning, by having to vote for it, that simple and direct mail voting could be eliminated would thwart the threat from SB 210. Do not depend upon that! Do not advance SB 210 from committee. Charles B. Miller, Corvallis
