Finally, by ensuring all ballots are received by election day and are verified in person or through secure identity processes, this bill helps avoid the chaos and uncertainty that can arise from delayed counting and system failures.

For every fraudulent or miscounted vote, a real voter's voice is silenced. SB 210 is a crucial step toward restoring public confidence in our democratic process.
