I oppose SB 210 because it undermines the accessibility and integrity of our elections by restricting the use of mail-in voting. Mail-in voting is a safe, secure, and time-tested method that expands participation, especially for seniors, people with disabilities, rural voters, working families, and others who may face barriers to voting in person. Numerous studies and bipartisan investigations have confirmed that voter fraud is exceedingly rare in mail-in ballots. By making in-person voting the only standard method, this bill threatens to disenfranchise eligible voters and weaken the inclusive, participatory foundation of our democracy.
