The justification for SB210, legal citizen requirement documentation and voting age, is already being met by the current mail in voter law. Oregon vote counting machines are not connected to the internet and ballot signatures are verified. The registration is nonaffiliated (not a member of the political party) so it is a citizen's choice to select a party through the OMV card. Everyone in the state who meets the previous requirements should be encouraged to vote and express their views.

By necessity, there must be a deadline e.g. ballot postmarked by election day ensures voter efforts will be counted no matter their work status, age, disability and demonstrates in practice our government cares about getting it's citizen input. Both voter drop boxes and mail should always be available to reduce dependency on a single delivery/pick-up method.
