With anything pertaining to law and the enforcement of law, I must present valid ID when;

I board a plane

I purchase a firearm

I purchase alcohol or tobacco

I am pulled over for a traffic violation

The lawful age for voting in Oregon is age 18 in all local, state, and federal elections. Current law mandates the same, as above, for voting, requiring there be valid ID presented for every person voting as a legal citizen and eligible to vote. This "up front" personal contact needs to be mandated and will provide transparency in our system, guaranting that each VOTING individual is a citizen of the USA, and confidence that the American citizens are being heard.
