I am strongly opposed to SB 210, and am confused why we would attempt as a state to fix something that is not broken. Making voting more difficult for eligible voters is a waste of taxpayer money and time, and distracts from the record number of critical bills we need to address this legislative session, including wildfire mitigation strategies in my wildfire prone community. SB 201 revokes Oregonian's long standing right to vote by mail and would undermine the accessibility and inclusivity that have been the hallmarks of Oregon's electoral system for decades. Oregon has been a leader in implementing a universal vote-by-mail system, which has significantly increased voter participation and streamlined the electoral process.
