Mail-in voting has worked in Oregon for over 20 years. It was started by Oregon Republicans to accommodate their rural and elderly voters. According to the Heritage Foundation's election fraud database, there have been only 17 cases of voter fraud in Oregon for 1982-2024, and only 1576 cases for the same time period, across all 50 states, out of tens of millions of votes cast. Mail-in voting is secure and increases voter turnout.
