SB210

Free, fair, and honest elections unmarred by fraud, errors, or suspicion are fundamental to maintaining our constitutional Republic. The right of American citizens to have their votes properly counted and tabulated, without illegal dilution, is vital to determining the rightful winner of an election.

Under the Constitution, State governments must safeguard American elections in compliance with Federal laws that protect Americans' voting rights and guard against dilution by illegal voting, discrimination, fraud, and other forms of malfeasance and error. Yet the United States has not adequately enforced Federal election requirements that, for example, prohibit States from counting ballots received after Election Day or prohibit non-citizens from registering to vote. Oregon has been blatantly negligent in protecting the voting process by registering and allowing non citizens to vote. The Oregon motor voter act has violated federal law by automatically registering id card and driver's license applicants to vote without properly vetting their citizenship. Other concerns are Oregon's Secretary of State allowing and enabling nefarious agents to "harvest" mail in ballots from non English speaking residents, homeless encampment residents, free needle exchange locations - drug rehab centers, and elder care facilities, the USPS delaying, losing, and destroying ballots, anarchist criminals tampering with and destroying ballot drop boxes, and keys to ballot drop boxes being stolen, misplaced, and unaccounted for making elections unsecure and unfairly biased by the Secretary of States own actions and/or inaction, to repair and stop any of these perpetrations by illegally ensuring the election outcomes will favor democrat candidates and liberal causes and measures costing not only millions to Oregon taxpayers but the death of thousands statewide due to damaging and destructive laws and measures being passed by unlawful means. The only remedy to deter voter fraud and these election crimes is to ensure in person voting for every election.
