Voting is Americans' most sacred right as citizens, and it is ridiculous and offensive to insist that Americans jump through extreme hoops in order to vote.

You know who can't jump through hoops? Disabled folks. Old folks. Folks in the hospital fighting illness. Folks who work full-time, sometimes at multiple jobs, and also have to care for children and family members. ALL of these people are entitled to the same right to vote that able-bodied, young, healthy, leisurely Americans enjoy. They do not deserve to be punished and marginalized in their time of need.

America is about making the voices of the people heard in our democracy. A country that makes efforts to burden, stress, and exclude our most vulnerable members from the ballot box is a barbaric and cruel country. A country that makes efforts to use modern, secure systems like vote-by-mail to accommodate all the millions of Americans who can't make it to the polls is a real democracy worthy of leadership globally.

Passing this bill would spit in the face of every struggling American. It's un-American and wrong.

Say yes to democracy and no to this disgusting bill that attacks the rights of the most vulnerable Americans.
