To members of this committee,

My name is Kye Doran. I live and work in Portland. I am testifying in opposition to SB 210.

Mail-in ballots are one the best things about living in Oregon. They contribute to us consistently having one of the highest rates of voter turn-out in the country. I am an active voter, and I look forward to receiving my ballot in the mail every election cycle.

SB 210 would drastically limit legal voters' ability to participate in our elections. Mail-in ballots allows legal voters to have ample time to research and fill-out their ballots without unnecessary constraints such as securing time off from work, arranging transportation and waiting in long poll lines. The basis for the introduction of SB 210 is based upon unfounded (and frankly xenophobic) claims of illegal voting, which is simply not happening in Oregon.
