SB210

I oppose any bill that seeks to eliminate, curtail, or condition any individual's right to vote by mail for any and all Oregon and federal elections. I therefore oppose this bill because it seeks to establish in-person voting as the standard method for voting in Oregon instead of vote-by/mail. Removing vote-by-mail does not fix any known problem in the state's election processes, builds barriers to voting, and encourages less informed voting behavior. Because there is no benefit to this bill, we must assume that the goal of this legislation is to reduce voter turnout, which is an affront to our democracy.
