In the interest of a free and open society, access to voting must be expanded, not restricted. Mail-in voting is everything that participating in government ought to be: easy, secure, and available.

Mail-in voting has a long and proven track record in the State of Oregon. The Oregon Secretary of State's website lists a 0.00006% rate of election voter fraud from 2000-2019. The fact that I have never had to wait in a line, prove that I was white enough to be there, or otherwise jump through the hoops of oppression to exercise my rights is a key factor in my ability and willingness to cast my vote.

I realize that taking away the right to vote by making the process a living nightmare is a tried and true political strategy that benefits fringe ideologies and further oppression, and I demand that you not allow anti-egalitarian, anti-democratic, and anti-freedom elements to oppose the bedrock of our society.
