I urge the Oregon State Senate Committee on Rules to Reject SB 210, repeal of the 2016 Oregon Motor Voter Act.

When I became an Oregon resident and citizen of this state, I found that a new driver's license application at the DMV covered voter registration, too.

I would be no closer to a physical polling place to cast an in-person vote than 8 miles away, a 16-mile round trip. For myself and other rural residents, including seniors, this imposes a major inconvenience.

The current vote-by-mail after registration at the DMV allows me to vote at my convenience, with a paper ballot where my signature on the ballot envelope can be conveniently verified.
