I Charla Chamberlain opposed the SB210 attempt to change voting from vote by mail, to in person.

Voting by mail has shown the greatest turn out by registered voters living in the state, by military members, and those temporarily living abroad. This is true among all age ranges, especially for the middle aged, those with families, the elderly, disabled, and the infirm.

Voting by mail makes casting a ballot the easiest it's ever been and also the best to achieve voting security. Digital ballots can be mass-altered, while mail in ballots must be counted by hand and leave a permanent record of the vote for recounts.
