
SB 886: Support



The Consolidated Oregon Indivisible Network (COIN) is a coalition of over 50 local Indivisible groups throughout Oregon that cooperate and amplify their joint efforts to advance important federal and state legislation and engage with elected officials to promote causes for the benefit of all Oregonians.

COIN supports SB 886, which would direct the Department of Transportation or county authorities to prioritize applications for renewable energy facilities and lines and facilities or systems for transmitting electricity from renewable energy facilities when reviewing or granting applications to place, build or construct on the right of way of a state highway or county road.

This makes sense. Oregon has not reduced its greenhouse gas emissions over the past 33 years, as illustrated by this chart by the Department of Environmental Quality. Prioritizing applications for renewable facilities and lines would help Oregon achieve its climate protection goals.
