Oregon's vote-by-mail system has been a resounding success, ensuring secure, accessible, and efficient elections for over two decades. Since its adoption statewide in the 1990's voter participation has consistently remained among the highest in the nation. The system increases accessibility for rural voters, seniors, and those with disabilities while eliminating long lines and reducing costs. With built-in security measures like signature verification and ballot tracking, Oregon's vote-by-mail process continues to serve as a national model for fair and transparent elections.
