I recognize that there are a number of Oregonians who are climate deniers. These people will always deny the seriousness of climate change because they are primarily motivated by their belief system. However, the social and economic costs from extreme weather events are staggering. In 2024, a record-breaking wildfire season burned 1.9 million acres and cost the state of Oregon taxpayers \$350 million to suppress. We had a similarly destructive wildfire season in 2020 in which Oregon Cascade towns such as Mill City, Detroit, and Blue River were destroyed.
