Oregon voted for well over a hundred years with in-person voting, using paper ballots. Paper ballots are the best way to assure the evidence of a vote remains available for recount and audit. Requiring state issued photo identification assures the person presenting the identification can be compared visually to the photograph and their name can be validated against the voting roll.
