Dear Senate Committee on Rules,

I write to share my SUPPORT for SB210 to restore confidence in Oregon's election process by:

- *Making in-person voting standard, with exceptions for military, overseas voters, and those unable to vote in person.
- *Requiring photo ID for voting and ballot requests.
- *Ensuring all mail-in ballots are received by Election Day – a standard already enforced in most states.

Oregon has a flawed process of registering voters that has led to illegally registered voters changing the outcome of elections by illegally voting. This is wrong and subverts the rights of honest Oregonians who are given the right to vote under the Constitution. Oregon leadership created this fraud of a system and it is past time that Oregon leadership fix all that is wrong before 54,600+ illegally registered voters interfere with the next election.
