I am strongly opposed to changing Oregon's long standing vote by mail system to and in person voting system. There is no evidence that voting by mail has resulted in higher than baseline election fraud in federal, state, or local elections in Oregon. This change would harm Oregonians' abilities to participate in the democratic voting process, not only for those with disabilities but for those that cannot vote in person on election day due to work obligations and those away from a polling place while traveling. Furthermore, in person voting may expose Oregonians to harassment at polling places as we have seen elsewhere in the US during recent elections. This proposed change is intended to be exclusionary and is direct opposition to our democratic principles.
