Direct Support Professionals (DSPs) play a vital role in our community, providing care and support to individuals who might otherwise be homeless or institutionalized, which would incur even greater costs. DSPs do not choose this career for financial gain; they are driven by compassion and a commitment to helping those in desperate need of care.

I urge you to take action to increase funding for the IDD community and move us toward closing this significant gap. Supporting higher wages for DSPs is not just an investment in these dedicated professionals, but in the well-being and dignity of the individuals they serve.
